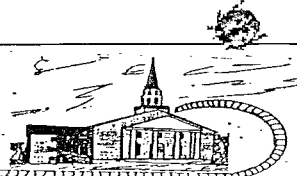

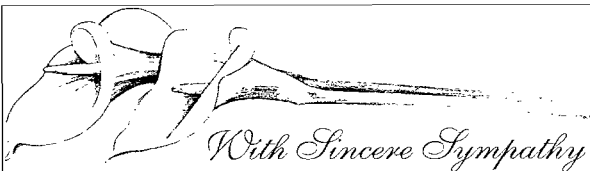

From the Pastor's Desk:

Our country faces a financial crisis with the likes unseen some say since the Great Depression, at least for most of us it is a crisis not seen in our lifetime. Maybe it has not affected you because you have a steady job with a steady income. But most of us have been affected by it. There are those who have been laid off, hours cut, some are working one week and then are off the next. We struggle to make ends meet because the ends are too far apart. What do you do? I am not going to tell you how to make a family budget to reduce your expenses or how to earn extra money. What I am going to tell you is simple and something that all of us can do no matter what our situation or no matter what the crisis. The simple answer is to turn to the God of the Universe. Turn to the one who is Sovereign and is still in charge. The simple answer is to pray.

You say, "Well, that's a pretty good Sunday School answer, preacher, but it don't put money in my pocket." How do you know, have you tried? Perhaps you haven't because it's been a long time since you prayed or you don't really know how. Let me share something with you to help in that regard. It is real simple and an easy thing to remember. All you have to remember is ACTS.

When we make the choice to pray, here are four easy things to do.

A - Adore. Praise the Lord. He is the one who made us and He is our Savior. He deserves our praise. He is God. He is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

C - Confess. Confess our failures before Him. When Isaiah saw the Lord high and lifted up on His throne with angels calling out "Holy, holy, holy", Isaiah's reaction was to cry out "I am an unclean man with unclean lips." When Peter realized that Jesus was Lord after catching a great number of fish he said, "Depart from me, for I am a sinner." The closer we get to God the more we realize just how sinful we are.

T - Thanksgiving. "How do I love thee, let me count the ways", says the poet. When down on our knees do we realize how much God has given us? Yes, we are in a crisis now, but what about all that God has done for us in the past, is doing for us today, and will do for us tomorrow!? Give Him thanks!

S - Share. This is where we bring what's on our mind to Him. This is where the rubber meets the road, as they say. This is where we lay our burdens at the cross of Calvary, at the feet of Jesus, and bring it to the altar. Whether our crisis is financial, relationship, family, health, or a crisis of faith, this is where we take it to the Lord, AND WE LEAVE IT THERE!

You might want to get some kneepads. Cause if your going to be doing this with every crisis, then you are going to be on your knees a lot! I know I am!

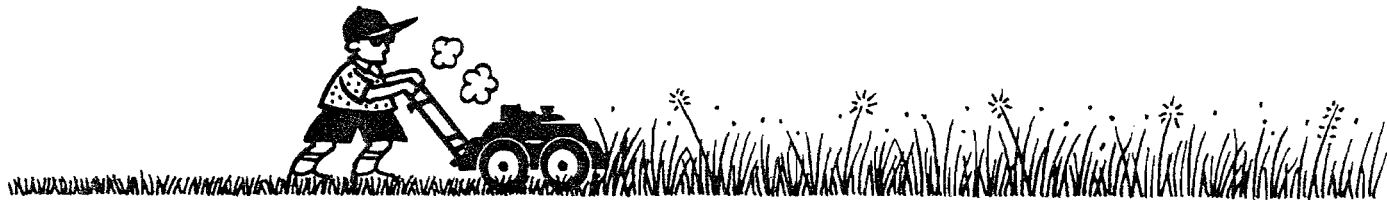
